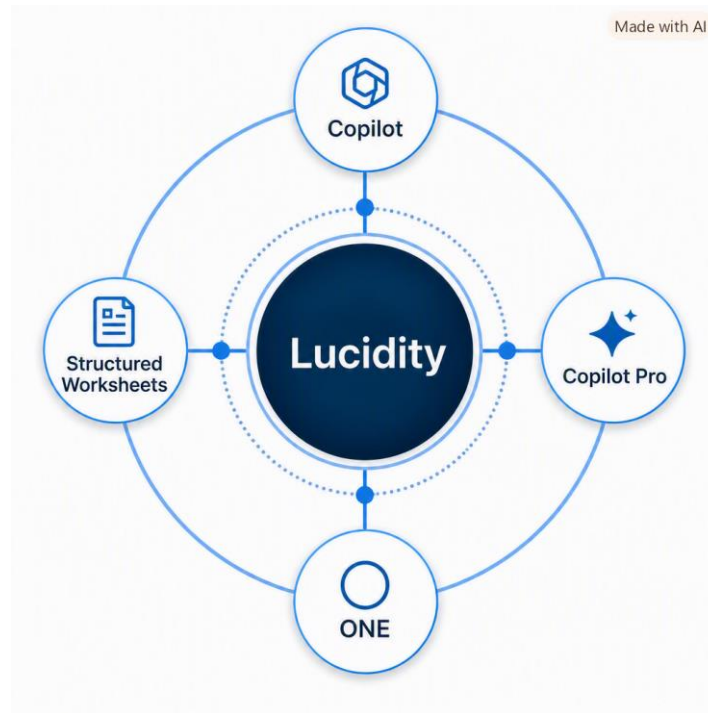

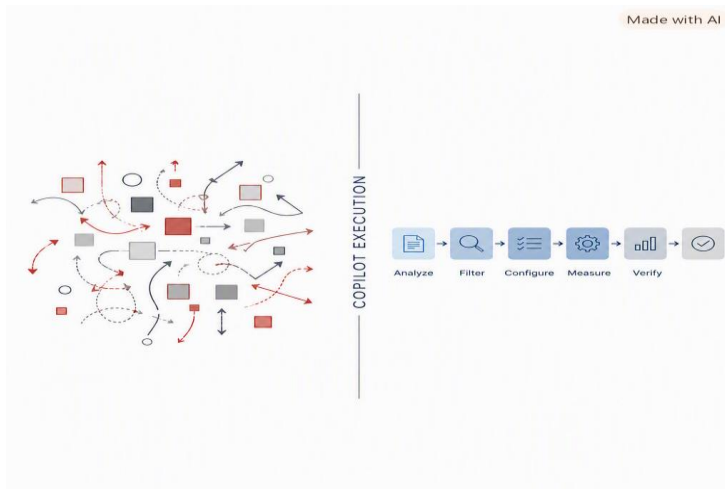
1. Executive Summary

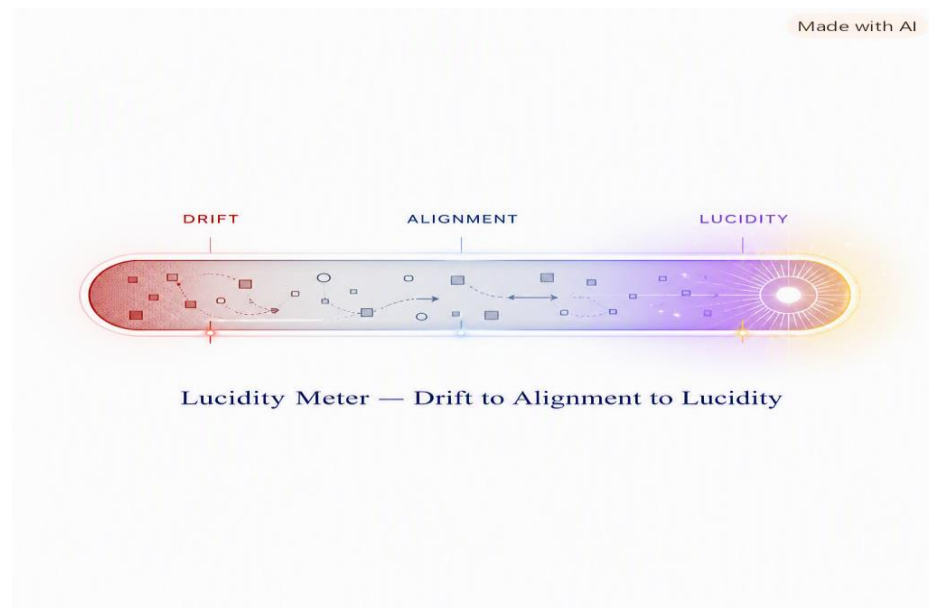
4.3 Copilot Lucidity — The Clarity State
